
## **ANDROID:** Sending one or a few photos from your phone to picseditor@probusbp.org.

- 1. In the "Gallery" app click on the 3 dots. Open and select Edit.
- 2. Tick your chosen image/s. A black tick in a white circle will appear.







4. Select your email program, fill in the Subject and add the recipient picspcbp@gmail.com in the 'To' line

5. Press send.




Larger numbers of photos: most email services (Gmail, Yahoo etc) limit file size to 25MB.

Storage like Google Drive, Dropbox etc enable sharing multiple images.

1. Google Photos. Open Google apps and select Photos.



2. Select a file or tap on individual photos



- 3. Click the Share button.
- 4. Select and click on the 'Create link' icon
- 4. Open your preferred email program, fill in the Subject line, add <a href="mailto:picspcbp@gmail.com">picspcbp@gmail.com</a> in the 'To' line
- 5. Press send.

Computers provide more ways to send photos. Through your email provider, you'll likely be able to use

1. Inside Gmail for example, you'll find that 'Attachment,' 'Link', 'Drive' and 'Photo Button' already integrated at the bottom of your email.

your Cloud storage — Google Drive for Gmail, OneDrive for Outlook.com or iCloud for Mail.

ATTACHMENT- will send a jpg, a pdf or word doc

LINK- will send bulk photos to another gmail account.



DRIVE- Press it, choose your file or photos, and send like a regular attachment.

PHOTO- insert a single photo into the body of the email
